It is the recommendation of the committee that Perkins Chapel Wilmore be declared an abandoned property and the congregation be dissolved.

New Presiding Elder District

It is the recommendation of the committee that the current Lexington District be divided into Two Presiding Elder's Districts.

The "Commonwealth District" will be comprised of: St. Paul, Lexington; Quinn Chapel, Lexington; St. Paul, Richmond; St. James, Cynthiana; St. Matthew, Midway; Shorter Chapel, Paris; Barnes Temple, Elsmere; St. James, Covington; and Wayman Chapel, Georgetown. (9 Churches)

The "Bluegrass District" will be comprised of: St. John, Frankfort; St. Paul, Versailles; St. James, Danville; Bethel, Boneyville; St. Peter, Harrodsburg; Davis Chapel, Somerset; Bethel, Campbellsville; Mt. Zion, Fraizer; St. John, Monticello; St. James, Ashland; St. Paul, Manchester; St. John, Greenup; Wayman Chapel, Barbourville; Allen Chapel, Moreland; and Craig Chapel, Salvisa. (15 Churches)
