

Report on Evangelism

In Christianity, Evangelism is the commitment or act of openly preaching the Gospel with emphasis on Christian Principles, and the deliberate intention of spreading the message and teachings of Jesus Christ. Christians, who specialize in evangelism are referred to as Evangelists. This group holds strong influence as Christian Leaders. Some Evangelist may have the opportunity to preach in their local communities; while others preach in unfamiliar areas.

Evangelism may be able to reach those, who traditionally might seem uncomfortable in a regular church setting.

Mark 16:15 NIV *"Go into all the World and preach the Gospel to every creature."*

Matthew 28:18-20 NIV *"Go and Teach or Make disciples of all Nations."*

Jesus told the disciples that in addition to sharing the Gospel, and directing people into an understanding of Who He is; they had the responsibility to make "Disciples of men."

Recommendations:

- Produce and print church tracts, deliver door to door
- Give your personal testimony
- Conduct outside worship and Church School service (i.e. Church in the community park, on church lawn, and parking area.)
- Neighborhood Night-welcome all, not just for the members
- Health Fairs, and educate on how to manage during a Disaster
- Holiday, no special day affair, just fellowship
- Invite Neighboring College students for After-School and Mentoring Programs
