The Conference Trustees met on September 6, 2019. The first property the Conference Trustees considered was Quinn Chapel AME Church which is located on 4248 Quinn Adam Street, Chattanooga, TN. The Conference Trustees reaffirmed to sell building and property for \$1.00 to the members of Quinn Chapel. Further, this decision is pending any and all releases financial or otherwise of the East Tennessee Conference, 13th Episcopal District and the African Methodist Episcopal Church.

The second property is Clayborn Temple AME Church located on 3115 Lay Ave, Knoxville, TN. The Conference Trustees reaffirmed to authorize Bethel AME to sell Clayborn Temple on behalf of the East Tennessee Annual Conference.

The third item is a request from Mt. View AME Church, Decherd, Tennessee. Mt. View is requesting permission to sell property lot 67 block E located in Decherd, TN. Further, Mt. View is requesting a resolution from the East Tennessee Annual Conference to procure a quick claim deed to combine St. John AME Church, Colored Methodist Church and Mt. View AME Church into one plot of land under the Mt. View AME Church name in Winchester, TN.
